## OUR PROGRAM WILL FEATURE:

### FOUR COURSES (CHOOSE TWO)

#### Imagining Justice: Comparative Law, Literature, and Pop Culture

Students will gain a deeper understanding of the social and cultural components of the legal profession by exploring the rich interdisciplinary connections between comparative law, literature and popular culture.

#### Conflict of Laws

Students will be introduced to the rules, doctrines, and principles that make up the field of Conflict of Laws, encompassing American, comparative, and international principles determining which law governs when multiple bodies of law and sovereigns are implicated in the same dispute.

#### Comparative Criminal Law and Procedure

Students will examine the procedural posture of the criminal justice system in America versus the rest of the world, including Spain, France, England, Italy, and Germany.

#### International Organizations

Students will gain insight into the nature and role of those institutions composed of three or more states, held together by intergovernmental agreement, and governed by international law.
